



1 'Ottoman Mosaic', in limestone, is one of the many extraordinary designs in stone conceived by Steve Charles. Here he has taken a repeated motif and translated it into a bas-relief stone mosaic. This design, along with others, can be executed in a wide range of stones, from £625 a square metre, at Steve Charles.

2 The oval 'Janice' dining table, 74 x 420 x 120cm, with an oak top and a leather-covered base, costs £7,910, at Philippe Hurel.

3 These glamorous cut-glass martini and shot glasses - £165 a box of two, and £175 a box of four, respectively - also come in black or red, and there are tumblers, Champagne flutes, highball glasses and cocktail shakers to match. All by David Redman, at George Renwick.

4 For over two-and-a-half millennia, the people of the Tien Shan mountains in Kyrgyzstan have been making hand-sewn felt rugs, which look equally handsome on the floor, or framed or unframed on a wall. This example, '2200001', 230 x 160cm, costs £1,650, at Felt.

5 Liz Connell's 'Vases' linen has a distinctly Fifties look. Seen here in seafoam, it costs £54 a metre, at Borderline.
